COVID-19: OSHA Updates Mask Guidance for Vaccinated Employees

On July 27, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) revised its COVID-19 [guidance](#), recommending that even individuals who have been fully vaccinated should resume wearing masks in public indoor settings in those areas of the U.S. that have substantial or high COVID-19 transmission rates. As of the date of this Pro Bono Brief, almost every Ohio county is in red on the CDC's latest community transmission map, indicating they have a high rate of community transmission.

On Aug. 13, 2021, OSHA released [updated guidance](#) on mitigating and preventing the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace. The new guidance updates OSHA's recommendations for fully vaccinated employees, and it supplements certain industry-specific guidance.
